

# INVASIVE WILDFLOWERS OF THE GUNFLINT TRAIL

## LUPINE

(*Lupinus polyphyllus*)

**Height:** 1-5 feet.

A garden escapee often seen on roadsides.

Blooms in mid summer.



## BIRDS-FOOT TREFOIL

(*Lotu corniculatus*)

**Height:** 1-2 feet.

Very common along roadsides. Blooms in mid summer.



## COMMON ST. JOHNSWORT

(*Hypericum perforatum*)

**Height:** 1-2.5 feet.

Found in sunny areas with sandy soil. Blooms in mid summer.



## KING DEVIL HAWKWEED

(*Hieracium piloselloides*)

**Height:** 10-20 inches.

Very common along roadsides. Blooms in mid summer.



## ORANGE HAWKWEED

(*Hieracium aurantiacum*)

**Height:** 10-20 inches.

Often found in fields and open areas. Blooms in mid summer.

# INVASIVE WILDFLOWERS OF THE GUNFLINT TRAIL

## **SWEET WHITE CLOVER**

*(Melilotus alba)*

**Height:** 3-5 feet.

Found along trails, roadsides, and open areas. Blooms mid to late summer.



## **COMMON TANSY**

*(Tanacetum vulgare)*

**Height:** 3-5 feet.

Found along roadsides and open, sunny areas. Blooms in late summer.



## **SPOTTED KNAPWEED**

*(Centurea maculosa)*

**Height:** 2-3 feet.

Thrives in dry, sandy soil. Blooms in late summer.



## **CANADA THISTLE**

*(Cirsium arvense)*

**Height:** 2-5 feet.

Common in disturbed areas. Blooms in late summer.



## **CREeping BELLFLOWER**

*(Campanula rapunculoides)*

**Height:** 1-2.5 feet.

Thrives in moist, shady areas. Blooms in late summer.
